Spirit we wait for your loving Son.

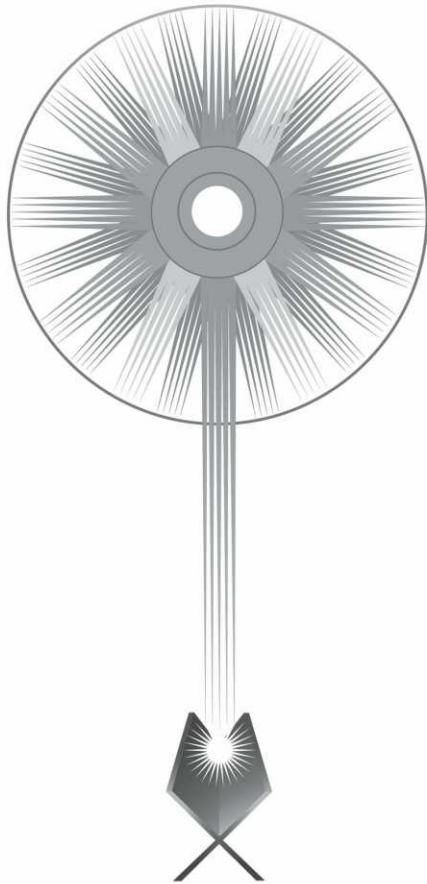
