Got Sacraments?

If your child is in need of the following Sacraments, now is the time to register for the classes.

**Children's Sacramental Preparation**

Because we are not a parish and our mission is to serve our university students, the CSC requirements for the preparation of younger children for the sacraments are the following:

- For all Children's Sacraments, the family needs to be registered and involved members of the CSC (i.e. by volunteering, helping through prayer, financial support, etc.) for six months prior to the beginning of classes.
- For **First Reconciliation & Communion**, the child must be baptized and in at least grade 2.
- For **Confirmation**, the child must be in 8<sup>th</sup> grade and have received the Sacraments of Baptism, First Reconciliation, and First Communion.
