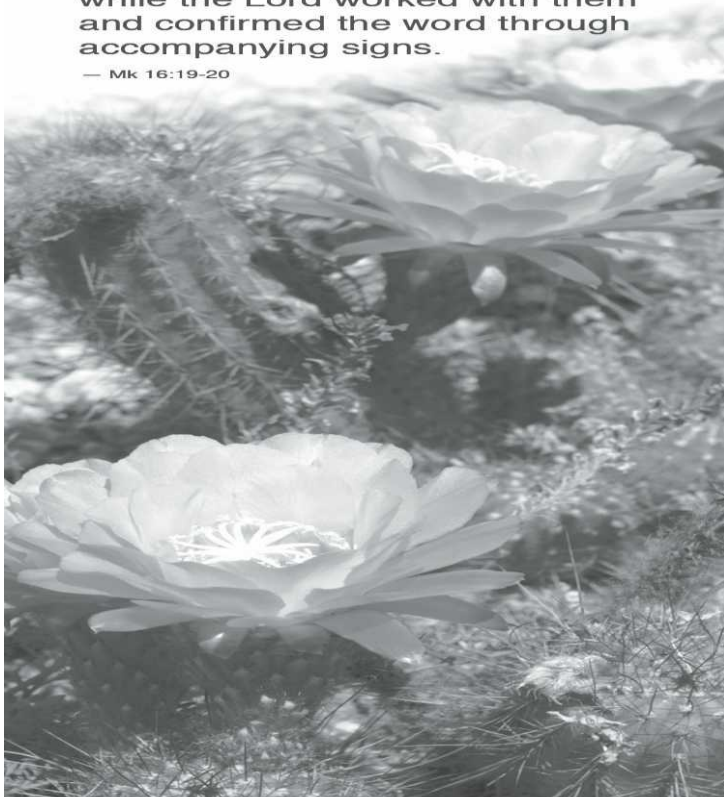
2012 Newman Gala Chairpersons
